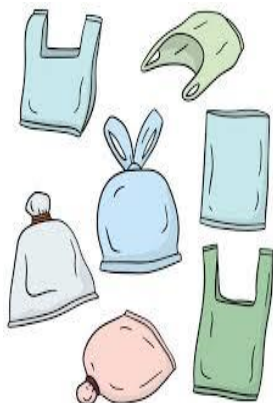
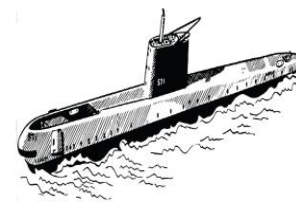
Question 2
